1. implement Task Force Recommendations that "fix the order of operations": eliminate the multiplicity of Cost-of-Living and Size Factors, Rebase the Cost-of-Living Factor based on recent data, and eliminate the Personnel Factor from the formula.

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At-Risk, ELL, and SPED will all be set at a 25% weight.

The Special Education Factor will account for all Special Education students. A weight for Tier B will not be included in the formula. The Categorical funding for Special Education will remain untouched and will continue to increase according to statute.

3. Target District Adjustments for Size and Cost-of-Living in response to the Task Force minority reports and stakeholder feedback and add a new Remoteness Factor.

The Size Factor will be capped at 6500 students (Task Force recommended 1,027).

The Cost-of-Living Factor will be capped at 23% (Task Force recommended 10%).

- 4. Creates a funding floor for districts in which their new formula funding cannot drop beneath FY24-25 under current law.
- 5. Implement 4-year averaging to address a more accurate count of students.
- 6. Implemented via a 6 year phase in.

## Approach #3 as of March 20

- 1. implement Task Force Recommendations that "fix the order of operations": eliminate the multiplicity of Cost-of-Living and Size Factors, Rebase the Cost-of-Living Factor based on recent data, and eliminate the Personnel Factor from the formula.
- 2. Increase Student Weights for At-Risk, English Language Learners, and add a new Special Education Factor.

At-Risk, ELL, and SPED will all be set at a 25% weight.

The Special Education Factor will account for all Special Education students. A weight for Tier B will not be included in the formula. The Categorical funding for Special Education will remain untouched and will continue to increase according to statute.

FY 2025-26

- 3. Target District Adjustments for Size and Cost-of-Living in response to the Task Force minority reports and stakeholder feedback and add a new Remoteness Factor.
- The Size Factor will be capped at 6500 students (Task Force recommended 1,027).

The Cost-of-Living Factor will be capped at 23% (Task Force recommended 10%).

- 4. Creates a funding floor for districts in which their new formula funding cannot drop beneath FY24-25 under current law.
- 5. Implement 4-year averaging to address a more accurate count of students.
- 6. Implemented via a 6 year phase in.
