

The Colorado League of Charter Schools and SchoolOps Present The Colorado Operations Leader Fellowship

Build. Lead. Transform.

The Colorado Operations Leader Fellowship is a free five-month professional learning program beginning in February 2026 that is designed to support charter school operations professionals as they grow their operations leadership skill set.

Who is this Fellowship for?

The fellowship is open to Colorado charter school staff working in operations. This includes current operations leaders, operations teammates looking to take on greater leadership responsibilities, and leaders at new charter schools opening in 2026 who own significant operations workstreams. Multiple teammates may attend per school.

Fellowship Components & Commitments Fellows will:

- Attend 2 full-day, in-person PD sessions in Denver and two virtual two-hour sessions on Zoom
- Regularly attend 1-1 virtual coaching sessions
- Create an individualized learning plan aligned to their development goals
- Complete a Capstone Project: a yearlong project that develops your leadership and improves your school
