- Facilitated budget readiness, onboarding, and reimbursement workflows supporting smooth fiscal starts.
- Expanded access to strategic financing through [Alpine Bank](#) line-of-credit partnerships.

- [GSC-CSP Prospect Cohort](#) launched — supporting new, replication, and expansion charter projects through monthly guidance aligned to upcoming CSP grant cycles (2025–2029).
