
Why This Matters

As it stands, **charter school students receive just \$6,300 in school facilities funding per pupil** for modernizing classrooms, improving athletics facilities, and enhancing libraries, **compared to \$21,000 for their traditional public school peers.** That's not fair.

Charter school families pay the same property taxes, but our schools are largely left out of local bond initiatives. That's why the Colorado League of Charter Schools is advocating to change this inequity by ensuring meaningful inclusion of charter schools in funding decisions and increasing transparency for voters, so that every public school student gets the resources they need to thrive.
